Statewide Train-the-Trainer Financial Education Workshops

The goal of these one-day workshops is to provide hands-on training on three financial education curriculums: the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas's "Building Wealth", the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation's "Money Smart Program", and Junior Achievement. The target audience includes: financial institutions, teachers, government agencies, non-profit organizations and community leaders who are committed to or are interested in providing consumer education and improving financial literacy in their communities.
