Texas Banking Commissioner Elected Chairman-Elect of CSBS Board

In May 2015 at the CSBS State-Federal Supervisory Forum in San Francisco, California, Banking Commissioner Charles G. Cooper was elected as Chairman-Elect to the 2015 – 2016 Conference of State Bank Supervisors (CSBS) Board of Directors. He also serves on the CSBS Executive Committee. The CSBS Board is comprised of 20 state supervisors and has supervision, control and direction of the affairs of CSBS, its affiliates, its committees and publications, and determines its policies and actively pursues its objectives.

Commissioner Cooper served as Vice Chair of the CSBS Board during 2014 – 2015 year until his election to the position of Chairman-Elect. He currently serves as the Chairman of the CSBS Finance, Compensation and Benefits Committee and serves as an active member on the CSBS Audit Committee, Legislative Committee, Regulatory Committee, the Emerging Payments Task Force, and is a member of the Community Bank Steering Group.

CSBS is the nationwide organization of banking regulators from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. For more than a century, CSBS has given state supervisors a national forum to coordinate supervision of their regulated entities and to develop regulatory policy. CSBS also provides training to state banking and financial regulators and represents its members before Congress and the federal financial regulatory agencies.
