Guadalupe National Bank, Kerrville, Texas, Converts to a State-Chartered Bank

Texas Banking Commissioner Charles G. Cooper announced today that Guadalupe National Bank, headquartered in Kerrville, Texas, has completed its conversion to a Texas state-chartered bank from a national charter. The new charter is effective as of June 29, 2018, at which point it will operate under the name Guadalupe Bank.

A wholly-owned subsidiary of Relationship Financial Corporation, Kerrville, Texas, Guadalupe Bank was originally chartered in March 2008 and will enter the state banking system with approximately \$153 million in assets. FDIC deposit insurance coverage for all deposits will continue without interruption or change.

The bank's executive team is led by Chairman, CEO, and President Gary A. "Tony" Roberts, Jr., who directs a staff of 33 operating two branch locations in Fredericksburg and Kerrville, in addition to its main facility in Kerrville. Guadalupe Bank takes great pride as a bank built by locals for locals, keeping its assets within the communities it serves and helping them grow.

"I welcome Guadalupe Bank to the Texas state banking system and applaud its clear commitment to providing sound, professional financial services to Kerr and Gillespie counties while maintaining strong personal relationships with customers," Commissioner Cooper said. "This is the very definition of community banking in Texas, and I look forward to working with the bank and its staff in the future."
