First Community Bank, National Association, San Benito, Texas, Converts to a State-Chartered Bank

Today, Texas Banking Commissioner Charles G. Cooper announced that First Community Bank, N.A., headquartered in San Benito, Texas, completed its conversion to a Texas state-chartered bank. Effective June 2, 2017, the bank will operate under the name of First Community Bank.

First Community Bank is a subsidiary of First San Benito Bancshares Corporation and has \$364 million in assets. The bank opened its doors for business in October 1979 as a community-oriented bank under the name of First National Bank of San Benito. The bank has nine locations in the Rio Grande Valley – Brownsville, Harlingen, Los Fresnos, San Benito, South Padre Island, McAllen and Raymondville.
