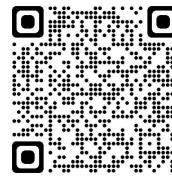

About the Texas Department of Banking

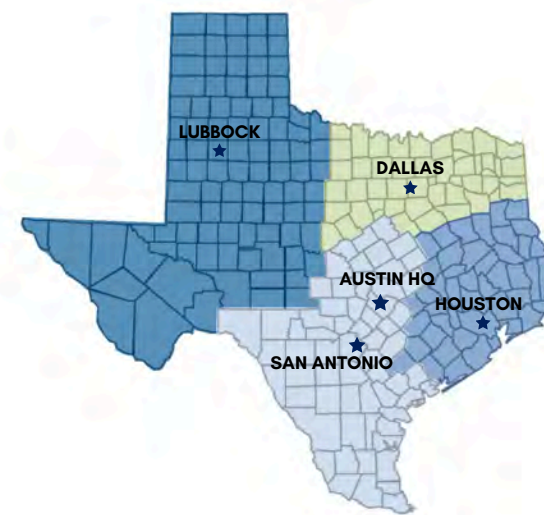
The mission of the Texas Department of Banking is to ensure Texans have access to a safe, sound and competitive financial services system. Our primary function is to supervise, examine, and regulate:

The Department is an industry leader in Cybersecurity and recognized nationally on banking and MSB matters. The Department works closely with the FDIC, the Federal Reserve, the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN) and a number of other state and federal agencies.

Our Offices

Financial Examiners are primarily based in one of our four regional offices – Dallas, Houston, San Antonio, and Lubbock – and travel 25-75% of the time during the week (including overnight) for on-site examinations.



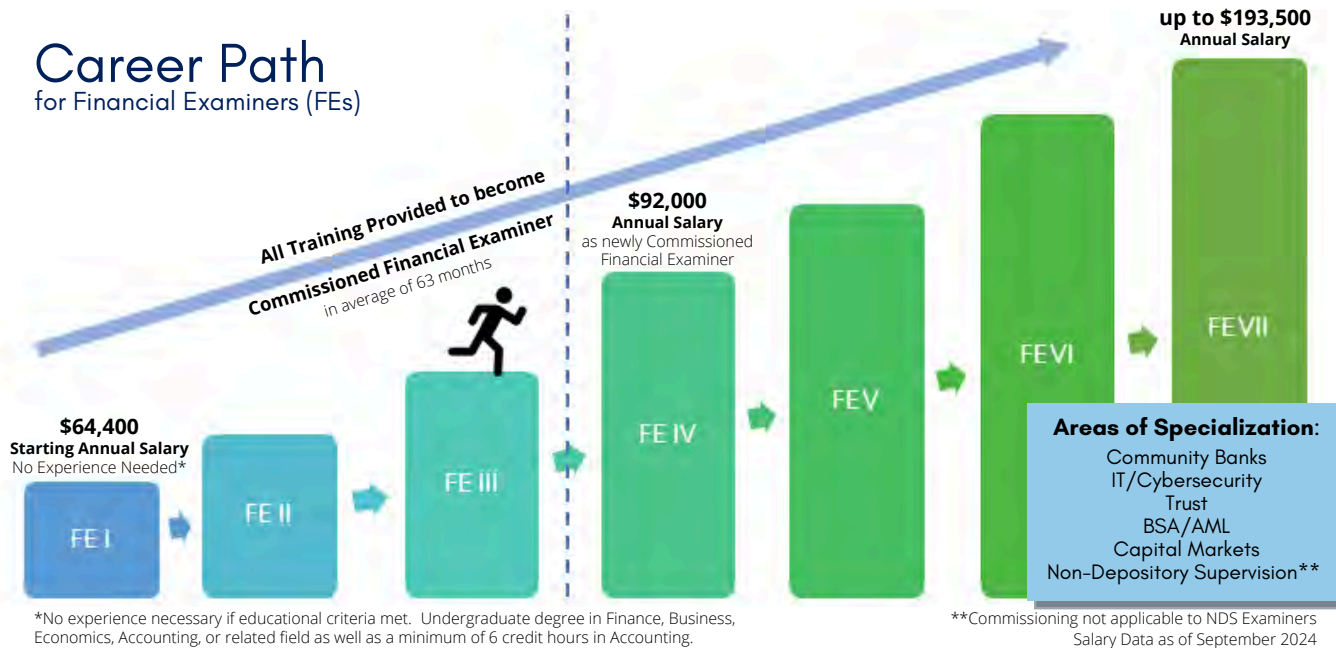
Grow With Us
