ORDER CANCELLING CHARTER

WHEREAS, Liberty Trust Company, LTA, Dallas, Texas (“Liberty Trust”), Charter No. 1052-44, is a trust company chartered by the state of Texas and subject to the jurisdiction of the Banking Commissioner of Texas pursuant to the Texas Trust Company Act (Finance Code §§ 181.001 *et seq.*) and,

WHEREAS, it further appears from the affidavits, resolutions, certifications, and other documentation filed by Liberty Trust with the Texas Department of Banking (the “Department”), that Liberty Trust has taken all actions necessary to voluntarily liquidate as required by Finance Code §§ 186.101-186.110.

NOW THEREFORE, based upon the complete record of the Department in this manner, I Charles G. Cooper, Banking Commissioner of Texas, find that Liberty Trust has fully complied with all requirements imposed by law for the voluntary dissolution and liquidation of a state-chartered trust company, and that its charter should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charter of Liberty Trust Company, LTA, Dallas, Texas, Charter No. 1052-44, be and hereby is cancelled, effective immediately.
