Texas Banking Commissioner Issues Order to Cease and Desist Activity Against Robert L. Green, Sr.

Commissioner Charles G. Cooper has issued an Order to Cease and Desist Activity against Robert L. Green, Sr, owner of the former Green's Mortuary, 2702 Avenue C in Bay City, Texas.

The Order, effective March 20, 2021, is based on the Commissioner's finding that Green violated Texas Finance Code, Chapter 154, by selling prepaid funeral benefits contracts and collecting related funds without a permit from the Department.

Prior to closing the mortuary on March 18, 2020, Green sold at least four illegal contracts for prepaid funeral benefits totaling \$17,924. Further, he continued to ignore multiple demands from the Department to refund the purchasers for the illegal contracts and provide copies of all similar contracts sold.

The Commissioner is authorized by Texas Finance Code § 154.408(a), to issue a cease and desist order to a person if he finds credible evidence that an individual has violated a law of this state relating to the sale of prepaid funeral benefits. The Order directs Green to cease and desist from engaging in the solicitation and sale of any trust-funded prepaid funeral contracts and the acceptance of related funds.
