Banking Commissioner Issues Order Prohibiting Further Participation Relating to Elijah Adam Vega

Texas Banking Commissioner Charles G. Cooper issued an Order Prohibiting Further Participation against Elijah Adam Vega of San Antonio, Texas, a former employee of First State Bank, San Angelo, Texas. The order became effective November 16, 2024.

The Commissioner determined that the statutory requirements for the issuance of a Prohibition Order as set forth in Texas Finance Code § 35.0035 have been met. Vega has finally been convicted, for purposes of § 35.0035, of a felony offense involving a bank, dishonesty, and a breach of trust, and his case is not subject to appellate review.

The Order provides that Vega is perpetually prohibited from serving as a director, officer, or employee of a state bank, state trust company, or holding company of a state bank, or as a director, officer, or employee with financial responsibility of any other entity chartered, registered, permitted, or licensed by the Commissioner.
